- This is the United Way of Northern British Columbia's 1st annual truck pull event in Terrace. It is part of the 2011 United Way Campaign Kick-Off activities.
- This year we will be using a Fire Truck, driven by an experienced Fire Department employee. This truck weighs 31,000 pounds.
- The teams will be required to pull the truck 50 feet in the shortest amount of time possible. The course will be along Emerson Street, between Lazelle and Park Avenues.
- The Pull will start at 10:30 a.m. and will end at approximately 11:30 p.m. with award presentations immediately afterwards.
- Each team will consist of a maximum of 10 members. All members must be at least 18 years of age. Teams can be mixed-gender or all male/female members.
- Awards will be presented for fastest time, best dressed/most spirited team, and most money raised.
- There will be plenty of room for spectators, so we encourage everyone to come out and support their favourite team!
- Each participant will be required to sign the team registration form (waiver) in order to finalize their registration.

→ Each team must obtain a minimum of \$250.00 in pledges in order to compete in the event. **The pledge money, pledge form and acknowledgment of risk waiver must be submitted to the United Way (202 – 4630 Lazelle Ave, Terrace), via the team coordinator by Friday, October 14, 2011.**
