| Prince Rupert ECD HUB | ECD HUB has been developed at Roosevelt School, which provides a drop-in program and services/workshops of various community resources, such as health and nutrition, diabetes prevention, etc. (2004 - 2008) |
| Prince Rupert Books for Babies | In conjunction with the Library, provided funding for the bags for Books for Babies. (2004 - 2005) |
| Prince Rupert Community Workshops | Held community workshops with large attendance featuring speakers such as Dr. Gordon Neufeld and Dr. Clyde Hertzman. (2004 - 2005) |
