Community Programs	Program Description
North Peace Community Resources Society	Family Place Programming- Daddy & Me are monthly community events for Dads and their children six and under; evening Mother Goose, a one 10 week series for Dads and working moms; Family Fun Friday Nights is a year round weekly drop-in with various activities for the whole family.
Fort St. John Literacy Society	The Mother Goose family literacy program will travel to all communities in the North Peace with the Words on Wheels Bus.
Fort St. John Library Association	Every Child Ready to Read – Train a group of parents and ECE workers to improve their understanding of the importance of early literacy and give them some specific tools to share books with children.
School District No. 60	Community Early Learning Coordinator- The CELC is responsible for the coordination of the Words On Wheels Bus. Additionally, the CELC sits on three ECD Community Tables: Fort St. John, Taylor and Hudson’s Hope. The CELC publishes schedules for the WOW Bus and is working with the Literacy Alliance to produce a comprehensive calendar that will include all early learning and literacy opportunities for children birth to five and their families.
Fort Nelson Family Development Society	Community Resource Liaison Consultant-Promote public awareness of ECD programs and services in Fort Nelson and importance of the first six years as the most critical period of a child’s development ;link with existing community events and business sector; create a central access point for community information and act as a hub for the community; enhance and promote community coordination of social development activities.
City of Fort St. John	Success by 6 Magazine, insert into City of Fort St. John Leisure Guide. Production twice a year of a publication for residents to raise awareness of early childhood development, program options and community services.
